Comprehensive Plan: The Commission received a copy of the final Virtual Workshop questionnaire for the Implementable Comprehensive Plan that will be included in the next newsletter and made available on line. The next Virtual Workshop item will focus on the preservation of greenspace since it was identified as a high priority in the community wide survey.

Additional Business: Ms. Green volunteered to be the Planning Commission representative for the Social Hall Study Committee. Mr. Dehart briefly reviewed why that study is being prepared and the goals. The study is a Community Center Feasibility Study that the PA DCNR is requiring to be completed before an application for grant funding to renovate the building can be filed.

Mr. Dehart also updated the Commission on the status of the Clover Development, Deerfield Preserve and Antler Ridge projects.
