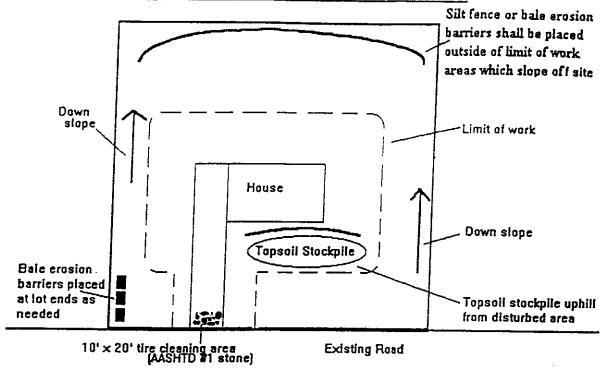

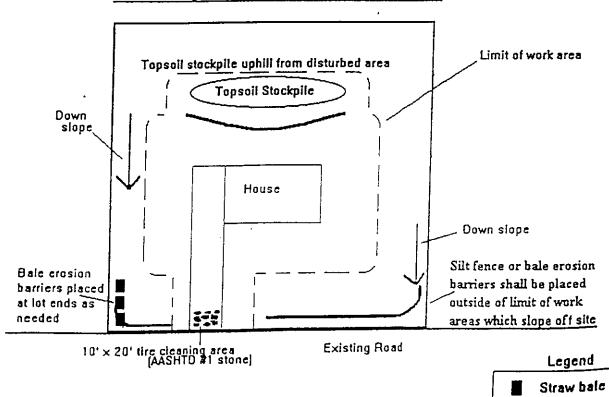


# Individual Lot Erosion Control

D. Permit hours. The operation of heavy construction or excavation machinery, including but not limited to bulldozers, high lifts, backhoes, trucks, power shovels, pump and jackhammers, and the operation of equipment, such as saws and drills or any other type of machinery used outside a structure, in conjunction with work requiring a building permit, which causes a noise sufficient to disturb the peace and general tranquility of the general public or any portion thereof, shall be prohibited in the entire Township between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., Monday through Saturday, and all day Sunday and on holidays.
