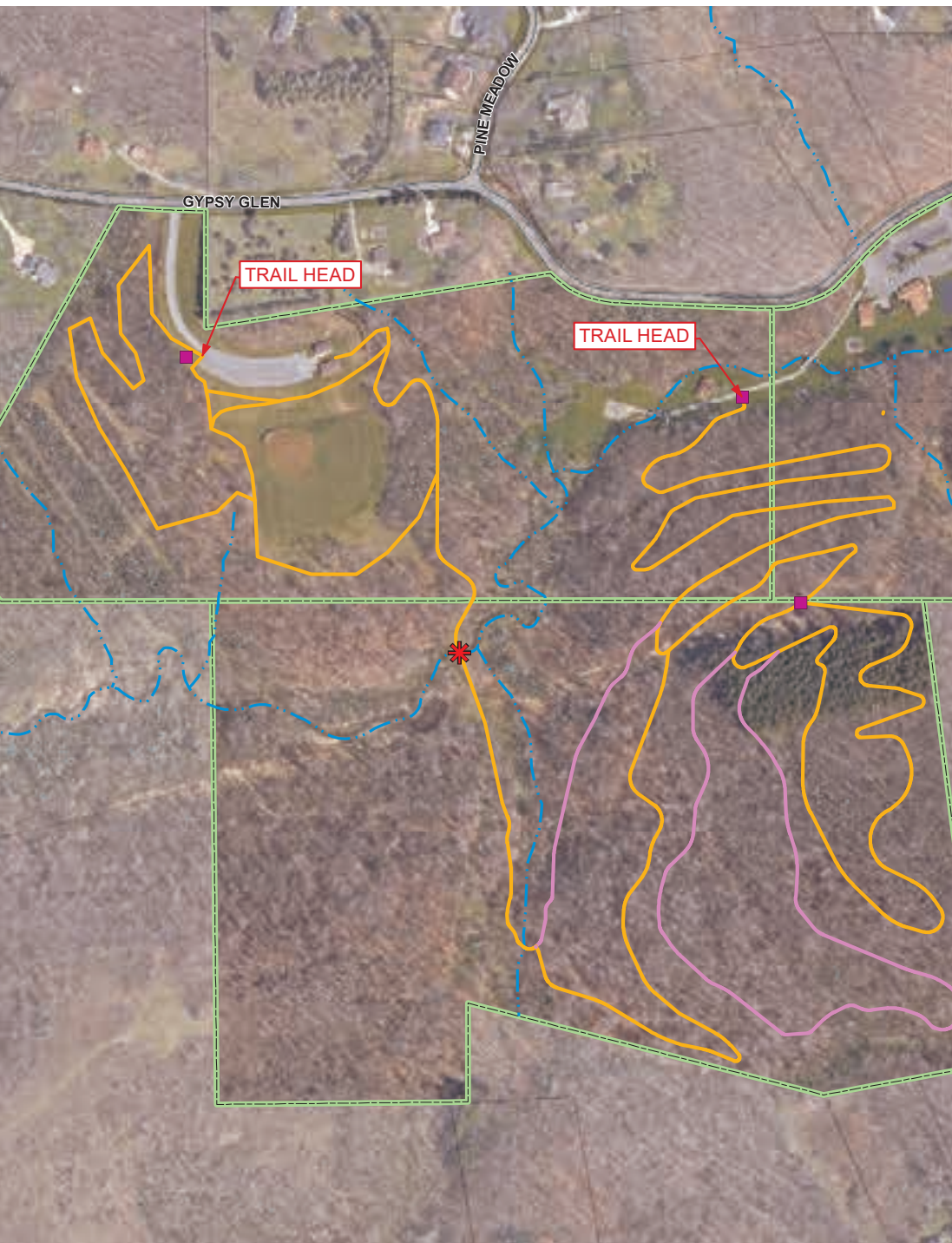


# Bradys Run Road Slide Repairs

The PA Department of Transportation has provided notice of planned landslide repair projects on Brady's Run Road during 2020. The first notice is of a project located west of Grange Road and is to repair the shoulder of the eastbound lane where it is failing in two locations over a length of approximately 300 feet and 200 feet. The project is to take approximately two to three months and be completed by September 2020. A firm start date has not been provided. Traffic will be detoured during the project.

The second notice is of a project on Brady's Run Road located between Achortown Road and Route 51 and is to repair the shoulder of the eastbound lane where it is failing over a length of approximately 450 feet. The project is anticipated to begin in the spring and be completed by fall 2020. Traffic will be detoured during the project.



## New Trail System to be Constructed

The Township is nearing completion of the design phase of the Two Mile Run Park trail project. The project includes the construction of approximately 2.25 miles of natural surface trail in a multiple loop system. The project includes two (2) trailhead locations, three (3) information kiosks, and a footbridge crossing over Two Mile Run Creek. The trail will be marked with universal symbols to identify trail difficulty by segments. Related amenities, such as trash receptacles and benches are included in the project scope.

Construction is anticipated between the spring and fall of 2020. Final plan approval is subject to the securing of a permit for the creek crossing and final design approval by the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR).

This project adds an additional recreation feature that was identified as a community need within the Two Mile Run Park Master Plan. A grant award of \$155,000 was secured from DCNR for this project.
